Call for Applications

Application deadline 22 April 2009
for mobilities starting during spring 2010 at the latest.

Triple I awards scholarships for studies and research in 19 European and Russian partner universities. Scholarships are available for undergraduate, master, doctorate, post-doctorate and academic staff mobilities.

The objective of the *Triple I – Integration, Interaction and Institutions* is to create an active network of Russian and European universities who cooperate multidisciplinary and multilaterally and promote innovation through joint research, education, and exchange of experience and good practices. *Triple I* awards scholarships within the theme of *Integration, Interaction and Institutions*. Duration of mobility can vary from one semester to 34 months. The mobilities for academic staff are 1-3 months. The grants are conditional to results of the European Commission Call for Proposals EACEA/35/08.
